

2017 PAY YOUR BILLS CONTEST RULES:

The following rules apply to all KZFM contests and prizes unless otherwise specified by a contest or promotion.

- Employees of Malkan Interactive, sponsors, affiliated companies and their immediate family and household members or **NOT** eligible to win.
- No purchase necessary.
- Must be a legal Texas resident at least 18 or older to enter.
- One winner per family and household per contest.
- A person can only win once every 30 days. For prizes valued at \$500 or more, a person can only win once every six months.
- For the Pay your Bills Promotion the maximum amount of the bill that will be paid by KZFM is \$500 and checks will be sent out (2) weeks after contest winner has been notified of win.
- KZFM Listeners are allowed multiple entries into the Pay Your Bills contest but will only be allowed to win once within the Pay Your Bills Promotion.
- KZFM is not responsible for late or lost mail, technical failures or errors.
- Winners may be required to present state photo ID, social security number and sign a liability release. Failure may result in forfeiture of the prize.
- Prizes must be claimed within 14 days of being notified prize is ready for pick up. Any prizes not claimed within 14 days shall be considered forfeited and will be redistributed.
- Winner responsible for all taxes and will receive a 1099 to file on taxes for IRS purposes.
- KZFM can substitute with prize of equal or greater value.
- Prizes not transferable or redeemable for cash.
- Entry constitutes consent to use your name, voice and likeness for any advertising or promotional purpose. KZFM may stop or suspend any contest, or change these rules at any time. Void where prohibited.
- All prizes awarded on-air must be picked up at the station's studios at 2117 Leopard Street during normal business hours of 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Prizes will not be mailed unless otherwise determined by the station. Prizes will be released to winners only.
